"Pitrupaksha is the period of the dark fortnight starting with the full moon after Ganesh Chaturthi and ending on the Amavasya before Navaratri. Pitrus are our ancestors, parents, grandparents and other relatives who have left this world. Pitru Tarpan is performed to pay respect to the departed ancestor's souls and get their blessings. By performing these rituals, Pitru attain peace and, in return, shower blessings of prosperity, health, and happiness on the family. Pitru Paksha Shradh can be performed by both men and women to honor their beloved family members who are no more with them!

In Hindu culture, Annadanam, donation of food & clothing to the poor, feeding animals & birds during Pitru paksha are all considered auspicious and believed to remove misery and mitigate ill effects of planets and increase good luck & blessings."
